Begin in **Chilaw**, visiting the sacred **Munneswaram** and **Manavari Temples**, where Lord Rama is believed to have worshipped Lord Shiva. Proceed to **Anuradhapura**, exploring ancient stupas and the revered **Kanniya Hot Springs**. In **Jaffna**, discover the **Nallur Kandaswamy Temple**, a significant site in the Ramayana trail.

Continue to **Trincomalee**, marveling at the majestic **Thirukoneswaram Temple**, perched atop Swami Rock, offering panoramic views of the Indian Ocean. Explore **Sigiriya**, where the iconic rock fortress stands as a testament to ancient engineering and is linked to the Ramayana legends. In **Kandy**, visit the **Temple of the Tooth Relic**, a significant Buddhist site.

Journey to **Nuwara Eliya**, often referred to as "Little England," to see the **Seetha Amman Temple**, believed to be the place where Sita was held captive, and the **Gayathri Peedam**, associated with King Ravana's son. Travel to **Ella**, known for its scenic beauty and the **Ravana Ella Falls**, associated with the legend of Ravana.

Visit **Kataragama**, a revered pilgrimage town that holds significance for multiple religions and is linked to Lord Karthikeya, who is believed to have assisted Lord Rama in his battle against Ravana. Explore the colonial charm of **Galle**, relax on the golden beaches of **Bentota**, and conclude your tour in **Colombo**, visiting the **Anjaneyar Temple**, dedicated to Lord Hanuman, and the **Kelaniya Temple**, linked to King Vibhishana's coronation.

This 12-day tour offers a blend of mythology, spirituality, and cultural exploration, bringing the epic Ramayana to life amidst Sri Lanka's scenic landscapes.



## Day 01 : Airport - Chilaw - Anuradhapura

\*Arrive at Sri Lanka Katunayake International Airport Warm welcome from our Ceylon discovery holidays representative and Chauffer at the airport.

\*After assistance at the airport proceed to Chilaw.

\*Visit Munneswaram Hindu Temple & Manavari Hindu Temple – Chilaw

**Munneswaram Temple** - Munneswaram Temple is the Place where the King Rama prayed to Shiva after committing the worst crime named as Brahmahasti. God Shiva blessed Lord Rama and advised him to install and praying four lingams at 5 places to get rid of dosham. One of the important Ramayana tour sites in Sri Lanka.

**Manavari Temple** - Manavari Temple is the first place where Lord Rama installed and prayed the Siva lingam. At present this lingam at Manavari temple is named as Ramalingam as this lingam was erected by Rama. Both Munneswaram Temple & Manavari Temples are very important Ramayana tour place.

\*Then proceed to Anuradhapura & Overnight stay and relax at the hotel.

## Day 02 : Anuradhapura - Jaffna

\*After breakfast proceed to Visit Anuradhapura ancient city.

\*After lunch starting a Anurdhapura “UNESCO” World Heritage site in Sri Lanka known for its ancient ruins.

\*Visit the isurumuniya temple and see the lovers statue, elephant pond and royal family carvings in stones.

\*Visit Sri Maha Bodiya, the oldest reckoned surviving historical tree in the world. Explore the sacred Bodhi tree, considered one of the oldest trees in the world, with a history dating back



over 2,200 years. It is said to be a sapling from the original Bodhi tree under which Buddha attained enlightenment.

\*Visit Ruwanwalisaya, mirisawatiya, jethawanarama, thuparama, lowamahapaya, kuttampokuna, Samadhi Buddha statue, sathmahal prasadaya, guard stone.

\*Visit sacred forest mountain where presence of Buddhism inaugurated in Sri Lanka.

\*Witness the most secured forest for numerous bio diversity, flora and fauna.

\*Visit the architectural beauty of world's largest granite statue which is considered one of the best sculptures in the world.

\*Visit the semi circular piece of stone which stood at the foot of a flight of steps in most Buddhist buildings.

\*Next visit is more popularly known as Mihintale. Arahant Mahinda, who came from India, met King Devanampiyatissa and his entourage on Poson Poya Day and preached Buddhism in Mihintale.

\*Then After proceed to Jaffna & Overnight stay and relax at the hotel.

## Day 03 : Jaffna

\*After breakfast proceed to Visit Jaffna city.

\*Morning Visit Nallur Kandaswamy Kovil (8:00 AM - 9:00 AM): Start your day by visiting the Nallur Kandaswamy Kovil, an iconic Hindu temple known for its vibrant architecture and religious significance. Furthermore one of the important places Sri Lanka Ramayana tour itinerary dedicated to Lord Murugan in the form of the divine spear well, which is considered as a well-known symbol of Tamil religiousness.

\*Next Visit the historic Jaffna Fort, which offers a mix of Portuguese, Dutch, and British architectural influences. Take in the views from the fort walls.

\*Visit Jaffna Library (12:00 PM - 1:00 PM): Visit the Jaffna Public Library, a symbol of Tamil culture and intellectual heritage.



\*Lunch experience at a local restaurant, sampling traditional Jaffna cuisine. Try specialties like Jaffna crab curry, string hoppers, or other regional dishes.

\*After Lunch proceed to Delft Island.

\* Take a boat to Delft Island to explore its unique attractions, including the wild horses, the Baobab tree, and the Dutch Fort.

\*Visit Point Pedro, the northernmost point of Sri Lanka. Take in the panoramic views and explore the area.

\*Next Visit Jaffna Market to experience the local culture and perhaps pick up some souvenirs.

\*Visit the iconic Jaffna Clock Tower, located in the heart of the city. It's a great spot for photographs.

\*Take a leisurely stroll along the Jaffna Promenade, enjoying the sunset.

\*Overnight stay and relax at the hotel.

## Day 04 : Jaffna - Trincomalee

\*After breakfast proceed to Trincomalee

\*On the way visit "Kanniya hot springs" there is 7 hot springs at Trincomalee . The temperature of the water released by the spring is about 42°C.

\*Take a visit to the Fort Fredrick which is still functional and has a magnificent view of the the surrounding ocean town, "THIRU KONESHWARAM" Hindu temple.

\*"THIRU KONESHWARAM" - Trincomalee believed to be built by sage Agasthyar as per the instructions of Lord Shiva who was impressed by the devotion of King Ravana. This place has the uniqueness of the lord building a temple for his devotee as a reward for his devotion.

\*Take an excursion to pigeon island for half day snorkeling tour. Named after the rock pigeon that colonized it the island, it has some of the best coral sites in Sri Lanka.



## Day 05 : Trincomalee - Sigiriya

\*After breakfast proceed to Sigiriya.

\*Most famous attraction in Sri Lanka. Sigiriya lion rock is one of the eight wonders. witness a fortress which was built on a rock 1600 years ago. This ancient rock fortress is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and offers stunning views of the surrounding landscape. Be sure to climb to the top and explore the well-preserved ruins Pack your gear and be prepared climb steps.

\*Next you get to try a beautiful srilankan traditional village experience.bullock cart ride,experience how srilankan people used to travel in the history.

\*Next visit, proceed to world heritage site – Dambulla cave temple. also known as the Golden Temple of Dambulla. It consists of five caves with stunning statues and paintings depicting the life of Lord Buddha.

\*Overnight stay and relax at the hotel.

## Day 06 : Sigiriya - Kandy

\*After breakfast proceed to Kandy.

\*Get to know about Srilankan spices, take a part in spice garden visit & free Ayurvedic Massage.

\*Check in to hotel & get a quick refresh.

\*Visit one of biggest attraction in sri lanka, Temple of the Sacred Tooth Relic(Also known as “Kandy Temple & “Daladha Maligawa”)

\*Kandy lake walk – Enjoy a peaceful walk around the scenic lake.

\*After if time permits take a part in Sri Lankan traditional kandiyen cultural show.

\*Overnight stay and relax at the hotel.



## Day 07 : Kandy - Nuwara Eliya

- \*After breakfast at the hotel proceed to visit “ROYAL BOTANIKAL GARDEN” at Peradeniya.
- \*Get to know about most famous Ceylon gem museum.
- \*Learn about how Sri Lankan handicrafts & famous batics are being done.
- \*On the way to NuwaraEliya (Little England), near “RAMBODA” area stop at “Shri Bhakta Hanuman” hindu Temple for few minutes, prepare your camera next stop will at beautiful “Ramboda” Waterfall.

Sri Bhaktha Hanuman Temple – Believed that Hanuman was searching for Sita Devi from a place called “Ravana Goda” close to this Bhakta Hanuman Temple. Sri Bhakta Hanuman Temple is one of the important Hanuman Temples in Sri Lanka and one of the important Ramayana proofs in Sri Lanka.

- \*On the way can visit tea factory & tea plantation ,Experience tea culture in Sri Lanka.
- \*Make sure you pack your camera, there will be few stop to capture the breathtaking views of Srilankan greeny hills.
- \*Famous stop over on the way to SriLankan hills,” DAMRO” tea plantation.
- \*Check in to the hotel in “Nuwra eliya” & refresh.
- \*Evening time to visit Gregory lake for sunset & walk around in Nuwara eliya town.
- \*Overnight stay and relax at the hotel.

## Day 08 : Nuwara Eliya - Ella

- \*After breakfast at the hotel proceed to Ella.
- \* Next Visit “Seetha amman hindu kovil” & “Ashoke wathilka”. Seetha Amman Temple – Seetha Amman temple is the only Hindu Temple which dedicated to Princess Sita in Sri Lanka. This is one of the important Ramayana evidence in Sri Lanka. Believed that the Sita Devi was kept captive at this site by King Ravana.



\*Next Visit “Divurumpola Temple”, where Princess Seeta performed the famous fire ordeal “Agni Pariksha” in order to prove her chastity to God Rama after being rescued by him where she came unscathed and proved her innocence and purity. One of the important “Ramayana yatra” Sri Lanka related site.

\*Enjoy with “Flying Ravana” Mega Zipline.

\*Visit Demodara 9 arch iconic brick and stone bridge by the British.

\*Ella is another ideal place for adventure lovers to experience their holiday to the best.

\*Visit Ravana cave in Ella that connects network of caves said to be connected to the Ravana Ella.

\*Overnight stay and relax at the hotel.

## Day 09 : Ella - Katharagama

\*Enjoy the view of mini Adam’s peak passing by tea plantation on the way up there and enjoy with morning sunrise, Climb at approximately 30 min climb through the at 05.30 am starting in order to the summit by down to witness morning sunrise.

## Day 10 : Katharagama - Galle - Bentota

\*After breakfast at the hotel proceed to Katharagama temple. Kataragama temple dedicated to the "God Skanda"

\*Next proceed & Visit "Ussangoda" Ramayana Site. Usaangoda is one of the torched areas, It is believed that Ussangoda during the time of Ramayana, King Ravana used this flat hard land to travel on his Pushpak Vimana.

\*Reach Galle and Visit "Rumassala sanjeevani" mountain.

\*After proceed to Galle

\*Experience limited collection of exhibitd from the protuguese ,Dutch and British period in three main galleries of tropical colonial Dutch building.

\*Visit Archaeological museum in Galle fort

\*Visit old post office, old library and old dutch church to experience the city in its true sense.

\*Visit Galle lighthouse also known as point de Galle light.

\*Visit rare historical jewel protected by dark, thick stone walls & UNESCO declared Heritage site dutch fort.

\*Next experience an amazing boat ride in "MADU" river through the mangroves. (red water trees)

\*Visit turtle hatchery, learn and experience about Srilankan turtels.



## Day 11 : Bentota - Colombo

- \*After breakfast at the hotel proceed to bentota.
- \*Bentota is famous for it's water sports. Jet ski, Banana, & Tube Boating, Diving, Snorkeling, Kite surfing, Fishing & Deep sea fishing are few among the popular list.
- \*Next proceed to Colombo
- \*Next Visit Kelaniya Vibhishana temple (Buddhist Temple) - Ramayana states that after the death of King Ravana , King Vibhishana was crowned by Lakshmana . So "Kelaniya Vibhishana Temple "is the place which had been ruled by Vibhishana
- \*Next Visit "Panchamuga Anjaneyar Temple – First Anjaneyar Temple" in Sri Lanka which dedicated to Lord Hanuman in his Panchamuga form, meaning five faces. "Panchamuga Anjaneyar Temple" in Colombo is one of important Ramayana related Hindu Temple in Colombo.
- \* Visit Galle face green & Old parliament in Srilanka.
- \*Next visit Independence square, Independence arcade & drive pass BMICH
- \*Our chauffeur will take you to "Gangarama" Buddhist temple. Don't forget take few beautiful memories.
- \*Take a small walk in the Green part & Viharamahadevi park.witness some beautiful Ceylon paintings.
- \*Visit Lotus tower,"The tallest sky scraper of srilanka".
- \*Visit jami - ul - Alfar Masjid. We knows "Res Mosque" and Petta bazaar.
- \*Later continue with shopping (ODEL/House of fashion/Ceylon Tea Shops/Sri Lankan handicraft & many more.
